Institute of Public Affairs Management Regulations for Rewarding Professor Research Works

Approved and issued by the Institute General Meeting on May 6, 1999.

Amended on June 24, 1999.

Revised on December 7, 2000.

- I. Full-time faculty members of the Institute of Public Affairs Management of National Sun Yat-sen University shall be recipients of rewards specified in the present regulations (not guest professors from the Ministry of Science and Technology not included).
- II. The regulations cover rewards for academic publications and books.
- III. A book in the present regulations refers to a published work of more than 200 pages or 100,000 words.
- III. The reward for each book is NT\$ 100,000.
- V. Authors with published works in academic journals or newsletters with review systems are awarded based on the following categories:
 - A. NT\$ 100,000 shall be awarded for each work published in SSCI or SCI international journals or newsletters.
 - B. NT\$ 30,000 shall be awarded for each work published in Class A domestic journals or newsletters.
 - C. For works of unidentified classes, compositions of members in editorial committees of journals or newsletters in which such works were published shall be referenced for determinations of journal/newsletter classes.
- VI. Faculty members who present their research in international conferences shall receive a research reward of NT\$ 10,000 each.

- VII. Academic publications issued each year for applying for research rewards may be deferred for a maximum of one year. For example, publication issued in School Year 87 may be used to apply for rewards in School Year 88. However, each publication may only be used to apply for a reward once.
- VIII. An individual's reward may not exceed NT\$ 100,000. However, those who publish in SSCI, SCI, or academic journals of similar classes may receive a maximum of NT\$ 150,000.
- IX. Applications for research publication awards of the institute shall be submitted before the end of August each year.
- X. The monetary rewards are based on the financial status each year. If funding is insufficient, rewards will be given based on the ratio of submitted works.
- XI. The present regulations shall be implemented following approvals of institute general meetings. The same procedure shall be carried out when amendments are to be made.
